RECENT PROJECTS IN THE MIDDLE EAST & THE UNITED STATES

Recent projects from the UAE, Mecca, Jeddah, Atlanta, Vero Beach, and the Panhandle of Florida, will address the effect of local public policy on architecture and urbanism, on development at the edge of beautiful natural settings, and on multi-family housing.



Scott Merrill received a BA from the University of Virginia and a Masters of Architecture from Yale University. He is the founder and principal designer for Merrill Pastor and Colgan Architects in Vero Beach, and the firm's work has been recognized by the Florida Association of the AIA and the national AIA, for both architecture and urban design. In 2004, Merrill and Pastor Architects was given the Arthur Ross Award. In 2012, Scott was awarded the Seaside Prize, the first to be recognized primarily for architecture. In 2016 the University of Notre Dame School of Architecture awarded Scott the Richard H. Driehaus Award. He was the inaugural recipient of the Florida CNU's Charles Barrett Award for his contribution to the architecture of New Urbanism. He has taught, lectured and juried throughout the country. The firm's work spans a range of building types, scales and settings.
